In addition to the information on the "Jeopardy Board," you need to know and be able to explain the following information:

Causes of the Civil War:

Sectionalism - What is this? How did it play into the stress that helped start the Civil War?

- Slavery Who had slaves and what were they used for? Who wrote the book that gave people an idea of what slavery was like? What was the book called?
- States' Rights Who did the South want to trade with? What did the North do to try and stop this trade?
- Westward Expansion What compromise decided whether the new Western states would be slave or free states?

Break Down of Compromises – What promises and/or compromises were broken?

Battles of the Civil War:

- Battle of Fort Sumter First official battle of the Civil War, considered the battle that started the Civil War, Confederate victory, 2 days long, zero casualties, and located in Charleston, SC
- Battle of Gettysburg Turning point of the Civil War, Union victory, 3 days long, over 50,000 casualties, and located in Gettysburg, PA
- Battle of Atlanta The beginning of "Sherman's March to the Sea," Union victory, 1 day long, and located in Atlanta, GA

The Kansas-Nebraska Act – What did this act do?

The Compromise of 1850 – What did this act do?
